Current or former foster youth

- 16 - 21 years of age
- Referred by County Social Worker or Probation Officer
- Voluntary participation

Who is eligible for After Care Services?

- Former foster youth between 18 and 21 years old
- One-on-one services and individual support in areas of employment, housing, education, resources, etc.
- Transitional Housing Program Plus (THP+) referrals (ages 18 - 24)
